Visiting IKEA in Russia Our (0) started in a minibus to the city of Moscow underground station. It was not raining, but it was (1) and there was ice on the street. In the open area behind the station we could see about 30 people waiting for a bus to the IKEA shop. This particular bus is unusual for two reasons – it is (2) and there is only one bus a day.
We got onto the bus and it drove over the bridge across the River Neva and out of the city. We saw the big yellow letters IKEA on a blue background from far away; they are on a sign that is higher than the trees. The same design is on the side of (3), a very big blue box with (4) all around it. We got out of the bus and walked along a special route to the entrance with a roof over it. We went into the shop through (5) that turned like a wheel. About ten people can walk inside one section of the wheel. IKEA shops are very popular everywhere in the world, and they are made to serve very large numbers of people.
Most places in Russia have (6) where you can leave your coat. On this day there were too many people, so only children could leave their coats. I had a heavy coat and they said that I should leave it in the room and carry only (7) If you have a child aged 3 to 6 you can leave him or her in a playroom (usually for two hours or just one hour on busy days). They give parents a piece of paper with the time of collection because some of them forget their children there! I don't know what people with dogs do.
The first place we went was up the stairs to the café. Here everything is self-service. You take a tray and ask people to serve you food, for example traditional Swedish meatballs. If you want (8), tea or a fizzy drink you pay for a cup and afterwards you fill it from a machine. While you eat and drink you can study the catalogue. They say that 160 million copies of the catalogue are printed all round the world. HACHIKO



In front of the enormous Shibuya train station in Tokyo, there is a life-size bronze statue of a dog. Even though the statue is very small when compared to the huge neon signs flashing, it isn't difficult to find. It has been used as a meeting point since 1934 and today you will find hundreds of people waiting there for their friends to arrivejust look for the crowds.

Hachiko, an Akita Inu dog, was born in 1923 and brought to Tokyo in 1924. His owner, Professor Eisaburo Uyeno and he were inseparable friends right from the start. Each day Hachiko would accompany his owner, a professor at the Imperial University, to Shibuya train station when he left for work. When he came back, the professor would always find the dog patiently waiting for him. Sadly, the professor died suddenly at work in 1925 before he could return home.

Although Hachiko was still a young dog, the bond between him and his owner was very strong and he continued to wait at the station every day. Sometimes, he would stay there for days at a time, though some believe that he kept returning because of the food he was given by street vendors. He became a familiar sight to travellers over time. In 1934, a statue of him was put outside the station. In 1935, Hachiko died at the place he last saw his friend alive.

<u>Jasmine:</u> Well, erm, my name's Jasmine, I'm 18 years old, I live in Cardiff - that's in Wales - and I'm training to be a beauty therapist.

Tess: Hmm. A beauty therapist! That's a great job. Now I'm going to ask the question. So Jasmine, which famous person, dead or alive would you like to meet?

Jasmine: Oh, I'd like to meet Shakira.

Ravi: Shakira. This'll be interesting. Can you tell us something about her?

<u>Jasmine:</u> Sure. She's a singer – and a dancer too – she's from Colombia and she sings in Spanish and English.

Tess: And why did you choose Shakira to talk about today?

<u>Jasmine:</u> Erm, for quite a lot of reasons. First, I think she's a fantastic singer. I just fell in love with her voice the first time I heard her sing. It's so different. And then, ... she writes her own songs – she wrote her first song when she was only 8 I think. I love singing and I write my own songs too, so I understand how difficult it is – and I'd love to sit down with her and write a song together. I'm sure she could teach me a lot.

Tess: Can you play any musical instruments?

<u>Jasmine:</u> The guitar and the piano. In the beginning she wrote songs and sang in Spanish, and she was very famous in Latin America, but she didn't speak English, so she had to learn it. And I think she learnt it really well. I admire her because she didn't just translate her old songs from Spanish to English – she wrote *new* ones in English. It isn't easy to write songs in a foreign language, but her words are great I think. She still sings in Spanish too – she records two versions of her songs, one in English and one in Spanish. Another reason I like her is because she's a mixture of different cultures, and that makes her music interesting. Her mother is from Colombia but her father is Lebanese, so there's a lot of Arabic influence in her music – and not only Arabic – there's Indian, Brazilian, Iranian - she's interested in all sorts of music. And I think she's a nice person too. Her videos are very, well you know, *sexy*, but I don't think she's really like that – she's got four dogs and she likes working in her garden, and she doesn't drink alcohol and she doesn't smoke

<u>Ravi:</u> Thanks Jasmine. Erm, one more question. What would you like to talk to Shakira about, if you could meet her?

<u>Jasmine:</u> Oh, lots of things. Like I said before, I'd like to ask her about how she writes her songs. And I'd like her to teach me how to dance. She's an incredible dancer.

Ravi: Thanks Jasmine, that was great. I think I'd really like to meet Shakira too.

Tess: Mmm. I'm sure you would, Ravi.
