



MIGUEL HERNANDEZ UNIVERSITY OF ELCHE: INTERNATIONAL STRATEGY

Internationalization is one of the main strategic priorities of the UMH. In order to accomplish this, it actively collaborates with other European, Latin American, Asian, North American, and African universities and institutions. These partnerships grow out of common goals and interests by members of the university community, are the result of previous collaboration, and are established by teaching, departmental, and research units with approval by the university governing body.

The UMH places special emphasis on the selection of its international partners, which are based on criteria of quality, complementariness, and opportunities resulting from collaboration. In recent years, the UMH has put different lines of action into motion that will develop throughout the 2014-2021 period. Included among these are improved mobility for the entire university community, both Incoming and Outgoing, the promotion of joint international degrees, internationalization at home, as well as strategic collaboration in teaching, research, training, and cooperation.

In the field of mobility, participation by students, faculty, and administrative personnel is promoted in international programs. Funds are also allocated for mobility outside the European Union through the UMH's Destino program.

In the field of education, a program of joint international undergraduate, master's, and doctoral degrees has been launched, based on agreements with international universities that improve the education of our students through greater international exposure. This will allow our campuses to attract a greater number of international students to take advantage of the educational opportunities offered at the UMH. This program's main objective for the 2014-2021 period will be the establishment of joint degree agreements that improve and complement the education of our students, and result in a valuable

asset for attracting international talent. Along with this initiative, English-language classroom instruction has begun. This will improve the professional capacity and international profile of our students, in addition to offering a range of educational options that improve the mobility and exchange options for international students at our campuses.
