SAFETY MEASURES

WILL CLASSES THIS YEAR BE FACE-TO-FACE?

Classes for the upcoming 2020-21 school year will take place within the classroom as much as public health conditions permit, and guidelines issued by the health authorities will be followed at all times. Course faculty will keep students informed about the manner that classes are taught.





I HAVE TESTED POSITIVE AND/OR AM QUARANTINED FOR COVID-19

Students who are COVID-positive or quarantined may not attend classes, and they are to follow the same procedures as they would for any other illness. They must contact their course instructors and inform them about their particular situation.

WHAT IF I FEEL POSSIBLE SYMPTOMS BEFORE ATTENDING CLASS?

Students with symptoms compatible with COVID-19 may not go on campus. In these cases, they should contact their health center or call 900 300 555. If symptoms appear during class, the student must leave the campus and call their health center.





I HAVE ATTENDED CLASS AND AM COVID-POSITIVE

Any student who has attended a class at the UMH and who has previously tested positive must contact their health center or call 900 300 555. SAFETY MEASURES AND INFECTION PREVENTION

- Classrooms are marked to ensure 1.5 meters of social distancing and they may not exceed 75% of their normal capacity.
- Students must attend class with a mask. If they forget theirs, students may request a mask from building concierges.
- Avoid groups, especially when entering and exiting classrooms/buildings.
- Hand sanitizer is available for students in dispensers placed near building entrances.
- Students must follow the **routes** marked within classrooms and around doorways.
